In Spain, they have developed a model by which private companies are mobilized and the Ministry signs agreements with private companies by which they prioritize providing employment to this group of women. These companies then enter into agreements with organizations that support this group of women. Through this approach, Spain has been able to provide employment to quite a number of women, despite the unemployment situation in Spain. As a result of this project, one of the municipalities in Norway - Sør Odal - have started a Pilot project with private companies in the area.

Project: Stop violence for health

The project aims to help prevent and reduce the incidence of domestic violence and to raise awareness of the area among helping health professionals. Fulfillment of the objectives will be based on comprehensive education of key professions (teachers and students of health and medical schools), prevention and research. There will be a training module including e-learning materials, instructional videos for paramedical professions (nurses, paramedics), and educational manuals. We will provide training for teachers and students of medical schools, including the possibility of gaining experience and expertise with the workers at a counselling centre and conducting undergraduate work. The output will be a comprehensive training module of e-learning materials, manuals which will be offered to other schools, students, hospitals, health professions. To provide training in schools for students, teachers and health workers there will be a trained team of internal trainers. In the area of prevention, a media campaign will be held to support the project and increase the motivation to seek professional help.

Project promoter: Estonian Institute for Open Society Research, Estonia

Project: Building a uniform system for the prevention of intimate partner violence (IPV) in Estonia.

The goals of the project are:

1. To demonstrate the financial cost of IPV
2. To integrate all parties dealing with IPV
3. To develop an integrated model of action incl. development of a specialists' training system based on common understanding, training materials for carrying out basic or additional training, training of teachers, who hold lectures on gender violence at universities (Academy of Security Sciences, University of Tartu, Tallinn University etc)
4. Awareness raising campaign among specialists dealing with victims of IPV

Project: "Creating and enhancing a multisectoral network to help the victims of sexual violence"

Presentation: Sexual violence is the most hidden of all kinds of violence, and often considered a taboo. The nature of sexual violence has been increasingly discussed publicly in Estonia over the years.

The presentation will focus more in informal education of raising public awareness about sexual violence (campaign and participation at the Festival of the Opinion Culture) and internet counseling service for sexual violence victims.

Project: "Children and youth with special needs, suffering from problems of sexual behaviour"

Presentation: Training children and youth with special needs (mentally challenged) on appropriate sexual behaviour that wouldn't harm the others and would keep themselves from being victimised.

In the Czech Republic, there are currently no special educational materials or methodologies for the work with **deaf youth** in the field of domestic violence. Yet people with a hearing impairment are in danger of domestic violence just like the ones without it, plus they have to deal with extra difficulties arising from their handicap, especially with the language barrier in both oral and written communication and with an insufficient orientation in reality and information. The project's goal is the prevention of domestic violence in the community of deaf youth with the use of strategies and materials with respect specific communication needs of the deaf (communication in sign language, dramatic methods, therapy and education through film). ***The project's content is an intensive extracurricular work with a group of deaf girls in two Czech cities and a consequential creation of educational materials: methodologies and a short film, which the girls will take part in.*** The film will be finished in December 2015.

Project Promoter: Tähtvere Women's Centre, Estonia

Project: "Preparation of Methodical Guidance Materials for Information Activities Aimed at Children Who Have Witnessed Domestic Violence, Performance of Information Activities, Enhancement of Cooperation Network, and Piloting of Services Meant for Children"

The general objectives of this project are to prepare guidance materials for information activities aimed at children who have witnessed intimate partner violence, to carry out information activities, to improve the operational capacity of the cooperation network, and to pilot new services meant for children.

Presentation: For the first time in Estonia, we will publish **a book and methodical guidance materials** (in Estonian and Russian) to explain everything related to intimate partner violence and the possibilities for escaping from it in a format that is understandable for children.
